Adult

Not museum pests. Often found in large numbers on sticky traps

Size: Less than 1mm

Shape: Thin and colourless

Antennae: Very long

Distinguishing features: They are spindly and they often have thin wings.

Often found on: Traps. They enter through windows and unfiltered air vents.
