



What's Eating Your Collection?

Black booklouse *Lepinotus*

Size: 0.5-2mm

Shape: Squarish

Colour: Brown to black

Antennae: long and thin

Distinguishing features: They are larger and darker than common booklice and wing buds can be seen under a high power microscope.

Adults and nymphs eat: Microscopic mould and starch.

They are damp indicators.
